Sundays and Major Feasts YEAR B

The 6 weeks before Lent (the last one interrupted) from 9th January to the 13th February (the 14th February is Ash Wednesday) then resuming with Monday, 21st May (the 7th Week) to 1st December.

On Ferial days the celebrant may choose any of the following:

i. One of the 34 Masses of Sundays of Ordinary Time.

The prayers or just the Opening Prayer may be taken from a different Sunday of the Year, or from the prayers for various needs and occasions.

ii. The Mass of any saint in the martyrology of that day.

iii. A Votive Mass.

iv. One of the Masses for various needs and occasions.
