Pope Francis proclaimed "We are never alone" and that Jesus is our defender, as he reflects on the Ascension. "We are never alone in our lives, we have this advocate who waits for us." The Pope centres his teaching on the line from the Creed that says, "he Ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father." "We are never alone, the Crucified and Risen Lord guides us and there are many brothers and sisters with us," he stated. Jesus' Ascension into heaven does not mean he is absent. Instead, it tells us that he is alive among us "in a new way." "The Ascension of Jesus into heaven then reveals to us this reality that is so comforting for our journey, (that) in Christ, true God and true man, our humanity was brought to God," the Pope remarked. Jesus "has opened the passage up for us," the Pope said, comparing Christ to a mountaineer who leads the climb up the rock face, has reached the summit and "draws us up to him leading us to God." "If we entrust our lives to him, if we let ourselves be guided by him we are sure to be in safe hands, in the hands of our Saviour, our advocate." *From a reflection to pilgrims in St Peter's Square – Pope Francis.*
