

Taking Another Look - Eucharist: An Intimate Gift.

Jesus loved to eat out, to share meals in the company of others. Moreover, he had an Open Table policy whereby no one at all was to be excluded from these meals. It is no surprise therefore that he chose a meal in which to perpetuate his presence with us. The final 'last supper' with its many foods to symbolise rescue from slavery and entry into freedom, was honed down by Jesus to the two basic foods of bread and wine. Over these two aspects, these two examples of all creation, Jesus said 'This is my Body, and this is my Blood.' If we take another look into the Inn on the road to Emmaus, when the Risen Christ was with the two unsuspecting disciples, we see that the moment he 'took the bread and broke it'- he could disappear from their sight because he was present in a new way, (he was in them!). There was no longer any need for them to see him then, nor for us to see him now. We know that the food we eat becomes part of our bodies. Jesus also knew this. Could he have chosen a more intimate way to be with us? If we really dared to ponder on this truth wouldn't we want to sit in silence for as long as possible after each com-union with him?
