Taking Another Look - Eucharist: A Cosmic Reality

'The Eucharist carries sublime significance when understood as the deepest symbol of the hidden secrets already buried and burning in the core of Creation. It is the liturgical expression of the living river of love that streamed out at the beginning of time and now flows everywhere . . . The mighty mystery of universal existence is encapsulated in one ordinary, daily sacramental moment. Every Mass is a cosmic event.'

So writes Fr. Daniel O'Leary.

“Yes, cosmic!” Pope John Paul 11 says in Ecclesia de Eucharistia, “Because even when the Eucharist is celebrated on the humble altar of a country church, it is always, in some way, celebrated on the altar of the world. It embraces, permeates and celebrates all Creation.”

The Eucharist, the Mass, is one uninterrupted happening. At any given moment of the day the words: “This is my Body” are being spoken somewhere on the planet. They have been one continuous utterance since the beginning of time. They were, says O'Leary, the words of creation when 'the first fiery atoms shattered the infinite darkness.. “This is my Body.” It is God-become-atom, become- galaxy, become- star, become-universe, become-earth, become-human, speaking these words of wonder to the whole of Creation in our own voice.'

At one moment in time, our Creator God, visibly incarnate in creation repeated the words: “This is my Body,” the Body that is the sign of his sacrifice in love for us, the sign of his continuing presence with us and in us. In the words of O'Leary “Without the Mass, we would surely forget that our beautiful God is very incarnate indeed!
