You may recall that the Statue of St. Joseph had to be removed from the church during the urgent work of treating the Dry Rot in the roof. During this period pictures of the original Statue of St. Joseph were displayed at the back of the church asking the question did anyone know what had happened to it? The original statue matched everything else in the church which comes from the woodcarvers in Ortisei, Northern Italy. The current Statue of St. Joseph is solid granite and was made to be placed outside in the open air! It takes four very strong men to manoeuvre it. (He is currently in the back yard of the Presbytery having been jet washed several times!) After a good deal of thought it is proposed that a stone plinth be built at the side of the front door of the Presbytery and the granite statue of St. Joseph be securely fixed into the plinth and then illuminated with a flood light at night! Ongoing investigations are being made to replace the statue in church with the original statue of St. Joseph with the child Jesus. The hope was, that this could have been in place for Christmas this year. However, it now looks as though it will be in place for the Feast of St Joseph, 19th March 2019!
