**All Eucharistic Ministers** are invited to renew their promises at the *Mass of the Lord's Supper* on Holy Thursday evening. This short ceremony of '*Renewal of Promises*' will take place just before Communion. During the '*Sign of Peace*' all Ministers should go forward and stand in front of the Altar. A copy of the promises are available and all Ministers who are able to take part are asked to collect a copy from the back of the Church.

**The Chrism Mass:** On **Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> April at 7.30pm** the Archbishop will be celebrating the Mass of Chrism at the Metropolitan Cathedral of Christ the King in Liverpool. The Archbishop hopes that as many clergy, religious and laity will try to participate in this important annual gathering of the local Church in the Archdiocese. Parking in the Cathedral Car Park will be severely restricted on the evening of the Chrism Mass. However, the University of Liverpool Car Park will be available for people to use if they are unable to use the Cathedral Car Park. **A 50-seater Coach is available for the Cathedral: £10.** Departs West Street Car Park 5.15pm and back about 10.15pm. Under 18's and University Students go free. Parking is free on the West Street Car Park at 5 pm.
